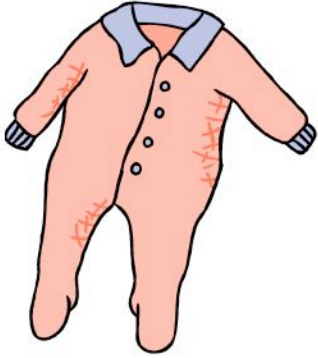


Baby's New Clothes
