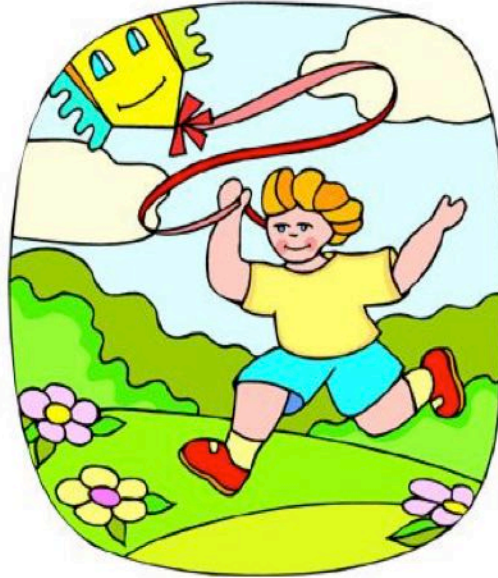
Run, run, run down the street
