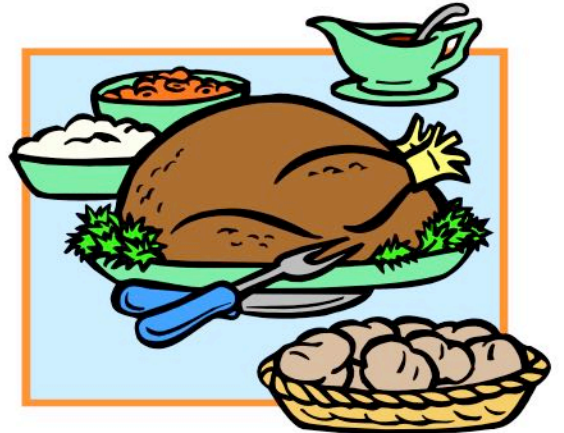


Thanksgiving Dinner
