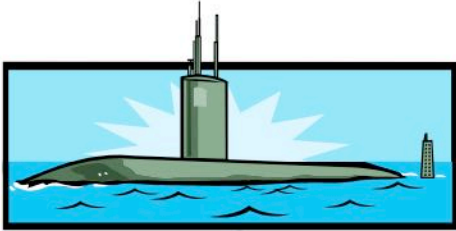


Bath Time

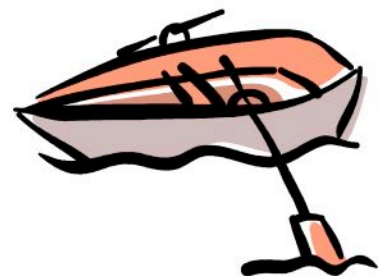
